



Financial Assistance Limits - 2023

Required documents:

- Previous year's tax return (**Not W-2 or 1099**)
- Proof of income from EVERYONE living in the household (current pay stub that shows year to date salary, letters or notices for Social Security, Supplemental Income, Disability, Unemployment Compensation, Veteran's Benefits, Pensions, Settlements, or any other type of income).
- Bank Statements – complete copies (ALL PAGES) of your TWO most recent bank statements.
- Records of tips, bonuses and commissions.
- Divorce decrees, alimony or support orders.
- If no income – you must have a NOTARIZED statement from the individual(s) providing financial support.
